**College of Arts & Sciences Degree Requirements for Minors:**

1. Minors may be added to any of the degrees offered through the College of Arts & Sciences.
2. Eighteen hours minimum are required.
3. Twelve hours minimum must be taken in residence, including nine advanced (3000-4000 level) hours.
4. A maximum of three credit hours from the major or secondary major may be applied to the minor.
5. A minimum GPA of 2.00 ("C") must be earned on all courses in the minor taken at Baylor.
6. Once the three required core classes have been completed, you may take the three upper-level elective courses. However, Studio Art Minors are not able to register for upper-level courses until after the majors have registered. When you are ready to take an upper-level studio course, visit the Art & Art History Office in HSFAC room 136, to fill out a brief course request form. You will be placed on a departmental waiting list, and after the majors have finished registering, any remaining available seats will be offered to the minors on this waiting list. You will receive an email from the Art Office, letting you know that a seat is available in your desired course, and giving you 24 hours to register for it. At that time, prerequisite waivers for ART 1311 and ART 1316 will be issued for you. Please note that there is no guarantee of enrollment into specific, high-demand upper-level studio art courses.
